1. Introduction:

With the passage of time, the seed of 'Kanya Kelavani' sown by revered Chhaganbha keeping in view to fulfil the objectives of social awareness and social obligation, has grown into a huge tree as Sarva Vidyalaya Kelavani Mandal. One of the strong branches of it is Uma Arts and Nathiba Commerce Mahila College, established in the year 1991 to provide quality education and thus to contribute to the social upliftment and 'women empowerment'. It is a matter of pride that in its constant journey towards development, the college has twice achieved 'A' Grade in its accreditation by NAAC, entitled as 'College with Potential Excellence', allotted RUSA and other grants.

2. Courses offered:

➤ Most of the faculty members of the college participated in on-line and presented papers in seminars, conferences and webinars and tried to keep themselves up-to-date with changing scenario of education.

7. Co-curricular and Cultural Activities:

This year, due to Corona pandemic, regular activities such as Youth Festival, Entrepreneurship, Sports, Cultural Programme (Kalshor), Prize Distribution Programme, Annual Day Celebration, Welcome Programme, C.W.D.C., Celebration of Navratri, Celebration of Various Days, Departmental Celebration, guest lectures and other events related to arts and skill could not be planned. However, the college tried its best to arrange some activities following the SOP and successfully organized the following activities.

8. Finishing School:

The college organized on-line finishing school under the banner of KCG and Career Counselling Committee, in which total 34 students from S.Y.B.A. and T.Y.B.A. actively participated and successfully completed the training. Shri Mehul Soni and Smt. Alisha worked as subject expert and trained the students properly to achieve the objectives of 'Finishing School'.

9. Self-Employment:

Tata Consultancy Services, Gandhinagar branch selected 56 girls from our college and provided them a training of 50 days covering 100 hours on topics like how to face an interview, corporate training, spoken English and reading test etc. 34 students from Commerce stream and 22 students from Arts stream participated and successfully in the training.

10. Job Placement:

The committee members of our college attended a meeting organized at Government Commerce College, Gandhinagar, and managed interview for total 196 girls of T.Y.B.A. and 101 girls of T.Y.B.Com in 15 different companies out of which 54 girls succeeded in getting jobs.

- Students made their participation in a national level seminar organized under 'Ek Bharat Shrestha Bharat' from 24/09/2020 to 30/09/2020.
- 7 Cadets participated in a state level Deference Camp from 05/11/2020 to 06/12/2020.
- The N.C.C. unit successfully organized various activities such as guest lectures, celebration of Republic Day, CATC camp training, Defense training etc. in which the cadets actively participated.

13. Library:

The college library has total 15,855 books of worth Rs.48,12,800 which is added by 73 books of Rs. 51,719 from College grant and 32 books as gift.

14. Faculty and Administrative Development Programme:

The college has organized Faculty and Administrative Development Programmes with keeping in view the changing scenario owing to corona virus. The entire teaching staff were given rigorous and hands-on training into various areas of ICT like google test, preparation of PPT, preparation of video lectures, etc. Almost entire teaching staff passed CCC+ examination taken by Government of Gujarat. For the first time, the entire internal exam was successfully conducted on-line. Similarly, the Administrative Staff was also trained into ICT issues and were prepared to deal with students on-line.
